1. John 1: 1- 9 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. All things were made through Him, and without Him was not anything made that was made. In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through Him. He was not the light, but came to bear witness to the light. The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world. He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, yet the world did not know Him.

Offering brought to the Altar

A Light that Flickered- promise in Genesis, Abraham

God's Promise was given to Abraham. He would have a son by the will and work of the Father. God was following through with the promise made to Abraham that he would be the father of many nations. Though Sarah was 90 and Abraham was 100, God made it possible, by His grace and will, for them to be blessed with a child whom God would use to be in the line to the Savior. The Light of Life and the miracle birth of Isaac; point us to God's hand guiding all things, so His Light would come into the world.

2. Genesis 12: 1-3 Now the Lord said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land I show you. And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and Him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

3. Genesis 17: 15-19 And God said to Abraham, "As for Sarai your wife, you shall not call her name Sarai, but Sarah shall be her name. I will bless her, and moreover, I will give you a son by her, I will bless her, and she shall become nations; kings of peoples shall come from her." Then Abraham fell on his face and laughed and said to himself, "Shall a child be born to a man who is a hundred years old? Shall Sarah, who is ninety years old bear a child? And Abraham said to God, "Oh that Ishmael might live before you!" God said, "No, but Sarah your wife shall bear a son, and you shall call his name Isaac. I will establish my covenant with him as an everlasting covenant for his offspring after him."

A Light that Illumined - opened the eyes of the blind, Gentiles, Sinners

The Light, illumined the minds and the hearts of those, who were not of His chosen people. He gave a Light to the Gentiles to enable them to see and receive His grace and the hope He sent into the world. Jesus came as the Lord of all and His light was sent to open the eyes of all people, all sinners. His light brings the gift of eternal life to those who are lost in sin.

4. Isaiah 9: 2 The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in the land of deep darkness on them has light shined.

5. Isaiah 9: 6-7 For to us a child is born, to us a Son is given; and the government shall be upon His shoulder, and His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and of peace there will be no end, on the throne of David and over His kingdom, to establish it and uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and forevermore.

A Light of Salvation- Promises of Old- God's Promises

There was a Light coming into the world. It was unlike any other light that had ever been upon the earth. It was the Light of God, in the form of a Child. It was the Christ-Child, Immanuel, God in the midst of His own people to bring them the only means by which all men could be saved. He came to accomplish the work and plan of the Father to save mankind from their sinfulness and iniquities. It was a promise from of old, but a promise that never wavered or changed. It was in the hands of the loving and gracious Father: which He carried out through His Son.

6. Isaiah 60: 1 – 3 Arise, shine, for your light has come and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you. For behold, darkness shall cover the earth, and thick darkness the peoples; but the Lord will arise upon you and His glory will be seen upon you. And nations shall come to Your light, and kings to the brightness of Your rising.

7. Micah 5: 2-5a But you, O Bethlehem Ephrathah, who are too little to be among the tribes of Judah, from you shall come forth for me One who is to be the ruler of Israel, whose coming forth is from of old, from ancient days. Therefore, He shall give them up until the time when she who is in labor has given birth; then the rest of his brothers shall return to the people Israel. And He shall stand and shepherd His flock in the strength of the Lord, in the majesty of the name of the Lord His God. And they shall dwell secure, for now He shall be great to the ends of the earth. And He shall be their peace.

8. Micah 7: 7-8, 9c But as for me, I look to the Lord; I will wait for the God of my salvation; my God will hear me. Rejoice not over me, O my enemy; when I fall, I shall rise; when I sit in darkness, the Lord will be a light to me..... He will bring me out to the light; I shall look upon His vindication.

A Light that Enlightened: Joseph

Joseph was a righteous man, a man of faith, which God chose to care for His Son on earth. Joseph was placed into an impossible situation with Mary being pregnant and it was not his own. So God visited him in a dream through an Angel of the Lord and brought the wisdom he needed in order to follow through with his promise of marriage. Joseph’s gift of faith enabled him to accomplish what was being asked of him by the Father. He was blessed with seeing the birth of the Son of God!

9. Matthew 1: 18-25 Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When His mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly. But as he considered these things, behold an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, “Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. She will bear a son, and you shall call His name, Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins.

10. All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had spoken by the prophets: “Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall call His name Immanuel” (which means, “God with us”). When Joseph awoke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him: he took her as his wife, but knew her not until she had given birth to a son. And he called His name Jesus.

Light that Amazed: Mary

Mary- was young, honorable, and a servant of her Lord. God sent the Arch Angel Gabriel to prepare her and help her understand what was going to take place in the coming year. She, the most blessed of all women, was going to conceive and fulfill the Plan of the Father to bring His Son into the world. There is no way anyone could understand how she felt or what she faced. Yet Mary, through the gift of faith, walked the path given her and she was able to “carry” the Son of God, and rejoiced over the wonder of His love and the anticipation of His birth.

11. Luke 1: 26- 33 In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God to a city in Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. And the virgin's name was Mary. And he came to her and said, "Greetings, O favored one, the Lord is with you!" But she was greatly troubled at the saying, and tried to discern what sort of greeting this might be. And the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus. He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High. And the Lord God will give to Him the throne of His father David, and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."

12. Luke 1: 34-38 And Mary said to the angel, "How will this be, since I am a virgin?" And the angel answered her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be called holy—the Son of God. And behold, your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son, and this is the sixth month with her who was barren. For nothing will be impossible with God. And Mary said, "Behold, I am the servant of the Lord; let it be to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her.

A Light that lived- He was born as the Light of the world

Mary and Joseph were the most highly blessed of any couple ever on earth. They shared the birth of their Lord and they looked upon the face of their salvation. His Light was life. He came as a Child, the Christ-Child; the only Son of the Father. The One true Messiah who would bring redemption for His people.

Jesus came into this world as a Jew, born of a Virgin, and declared by God as the King of all people. He came as the humble Child, born in a manger, born as a descendant of David, born in a cattle stall, and laid on hay in a manger. God Almighty- the Light of the World, came into the world in the most humble of means to save His people.

13. Luke 2: 1-7 In those days a decree went out from Caesar Augustus that all the world should be registered. This was the first registration when Quirinius was governor of Syria. And all went to be registered, each to his own town. And Joseph also went up from Galilee, from the town of Nazareth, to Judea, to the city of David, which is called Bethlehem, because he was of the house and lineage of David, to be registered with Mary, his betrothed, who was with child. And while they were there, the time came for her to give birth. And she gave birth to her firstborn son and wrapped him in swaddling cloths and laid him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

A Light Heavenly choirs- Shepherds

The Shepherds, raising sheep for temple sacrifice, were chosen by the Father to hear the long promised Messiah had been born. They were chosen to hear the Angels of heaven proclaim the wonder of His birth. They were chosen to help point us to the truth of Christ being the "Shepherd of His Sheep" who had come into the world to care for His people. No other group of human beings has ever experienced anything as awesome as what they were given the blessing of seeing.

14. Luke 2: 8-14 And in the same region there were shepherds out in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And an angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were filled with fear. And the angel said to them, "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord. And this will be a sign for you: you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling cloths and lying in a manger." And suddenly there was with the angels a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying, "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace among those with whom He is pleased!"
