#### **SUMMARY OF VOTER'S MEETING HELD ON APRIL 6, 2025**

The Regular Voter's Meeting was held on April 6, 2025.

Pastor requested we welcome into membership Sandra Brown from Our Saviour. A motion passed to accept into membership Sandra Brown.

The financial report was distributed. A motion passed to approve the financial report as presented.

The technology and volunteer coordinator will attend the next Elder's meeting with a proposal for the database software. A motion passed giving the Elders the authority to purchase the software they agree is best for our congregation.

The Trustees received an estimate of \$3,250 for a carport and \$9,975 for an extension to the garage for the church van. After discussion by the voters, a motion passed approving \$9,975 for the construction of the extension to the garage.
